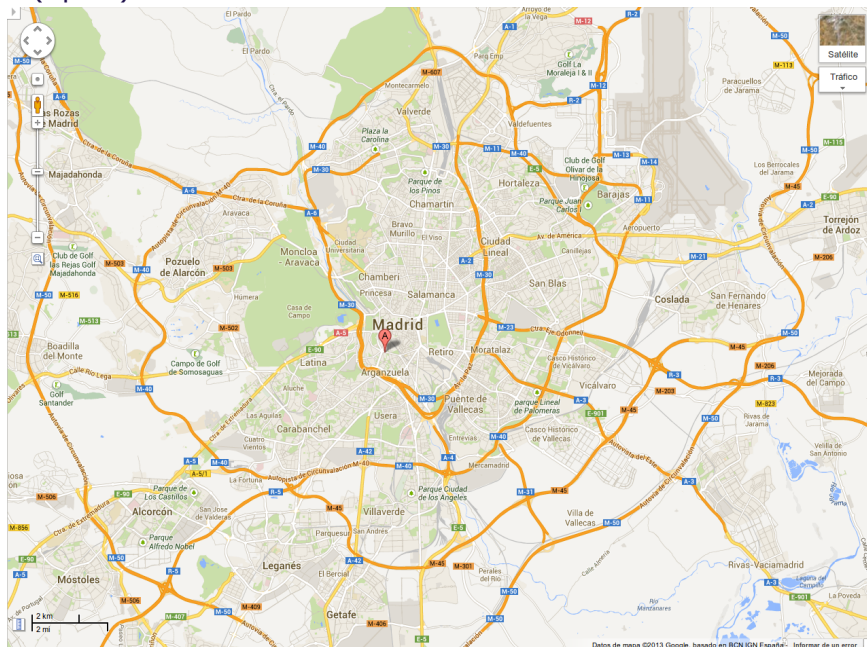
Campus Madrid - Puerta de Toledo (also referred as Mercado Puerta de Toledo in some indications) is located in the southwest of Madrid downtown, at walking distance from the historical city centre. Therefore, the transportation choices are multiple.

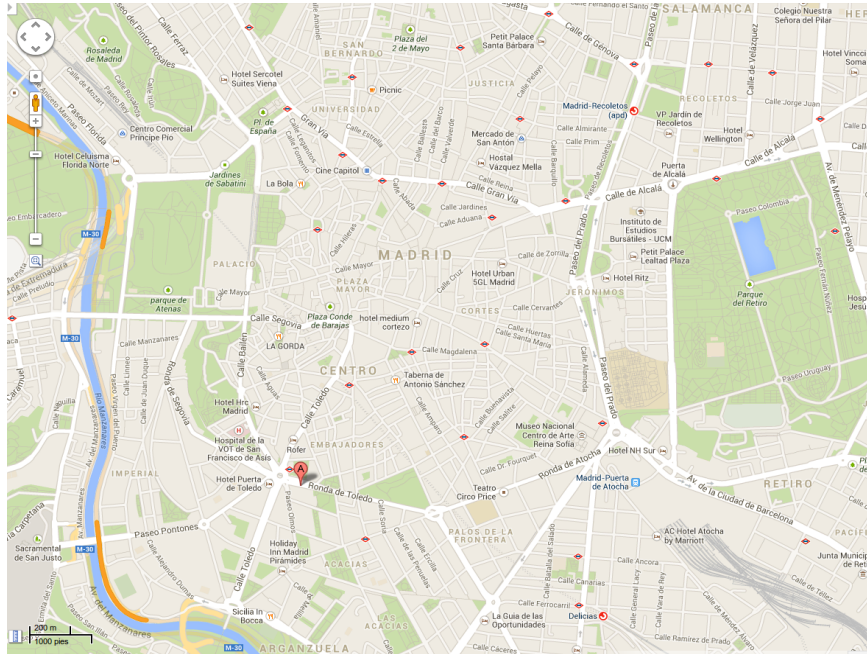

Suburban train (*Cercanías*):

- **Pirámides** (C-1, C-7 and C-10 lines): 8 min. walking distance
- **Embajadores** (C-5 line): 10 min. walking distance

Metro:

- **Puerta de Toledo** (line **5**), just 50m from the Campus

Car:

Due to the proximity to the city centre, access can be problematic, especially during rush hours (7.30-9.30am, 1-2.30pm, 7.30-9pm).

Train:

The main train station is Madrid Puerta de Atocha. Take C-5 suburban train line to Embajadores (2 min) or C-1, C-10 to Pirámides (do not take C-7 if you do not want to spend one hour!). From both stations, you can walk to Campus Puerta de Toledo (see above) or take the metro **5** line for just two or one stop, respectively, to Puerta de Toledo station.

Airport:

Madrid - Barajas is located 15 km from Madrid, and is served by suburban train, metro and several bus lines. There is a free shuttle service (green and blue buses) between terminals.

- From Terminal T-4, take the C-1 suburban train line to Pirámides (35 min), and take the metro **5** line to Puerta de Toledo (two stations), or just walk to the campus (see above)
- From Terminals T-1 or T-2, take the metro: line **8** to Nuevos Ministerios, then transfer to line **10** to Alonso Martínez, and finally transfer again to line **5** to Puerta de Toledo (total time around 50 min). Or take the shuttle to T-4 and the suburban train, as above.
